

QSCA State Team Qualifying Criteria

1. State Team Qualifying criteria:

- 1.1. Qualifying series are a number of QSCA Qualifying events as agreed & advertised by the QLD Sporting Clay Association at the beginning of every Calendar year The QSCA State titles will form part of the selection series,
- 1.2. Attend and compete at the advertised /officially recognised QSCA Qualifying shoot event – maximum of 1 (one) qualifying shoot event can be dropped. (The lowest or worst score to be dropped if a competitor attends all Selection shoots in the series for that year)
- 1.3. Attend and compete at QSCA State Titles Qualifying shoot – score to be added to the remaining qualifying scores from qualifying events.
- 1.4. Qualifying series exclusions are not allowed without authorisation for substitution by the QSCA Committee. See reference below.
- 1.5. **Exemption from attending/competing in the qualifying series may be sought under the following conditions.**
 - 1.5.1. Notice to the QSCA Target Director/QSCA Committee prior to the commencement of the vent in writing, if the shooter is unable to compete at one or more of the series events due to
 - 1.5.2. Competitive commitments at an equal or greater QSCA Sporting Clay event, either within Australia or overseas. The event must be approved by the Clay Target Director/QSCA Committee
 - 1.5.3. Illness or physical incapacity to shoot due to unforeseen circumstance. Doctor's certificate to be provided.

2. The QSC State Team Selection

2.1. Selection criteria

- 2.1.1.** The method of selection and the composition of QSCA Team, shall be determined by the QSCA Committee, upon receipt of recommendations from the QSCA Clay Target Director.
- 2.1.2.** Selection will be based not only on proven ability and availability, but will also take into consideration the potential team compatibility and the
- 2.1.3.** suitability of an individual as an ambassador for Queensland and the QSCA.
- 2.1.4.** Any individual rejected from selection in an QSCA Team shall have the right to request the reasons

3. QSCA Team Composition to

- 3.1. The team to Represent QSCA at the Annual SCA Sporting Nationals will consist of –
- 3.2. Seven (7) member team made up from the Criteria below -
 - 3.2.1. Four (4) Open Members** (Formed from any of the QSCA top qualifiers from the Men, Ladies, Juniors, Senior, Veteran, Master Divisions)
 - 3.2.2. One (1) Lady**
 - 3.2.3. One (1) Senior** (Formed from any of the top qualifiers from the Senior, Veteran, Master Division as per SCA age specification/SCA Rules)
 - 3.2.4. One (1) Junior** (21 years of age as per SCA age specification/SCA Rules)

The QSC committee ruling shall be final

The QSC Committee shall be the management committee of the Queensland Sporting Clays Association
